

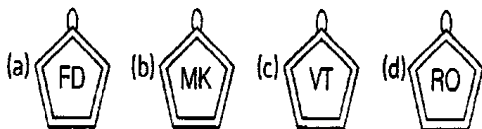

1. Some letters are written on the toffees shown below. Identify the relation between the letters on the first toffee and then find the missing letters.

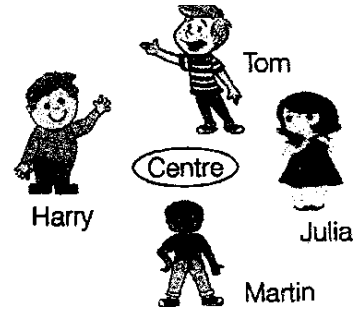
